

## October 2024 Admission Application Guidelines for the Admission

# to the Higher Agricultural Specialist Program for the Russian Federation Far East for the Doctoral Degree at the Graduate School of Science and Technology, Niigata University

The Graduate School of Science and Technology, Niigata University, offers a program, the Higher Agricultural Specialist Program for the Russian Federation Far East, which was selected as one of the International Priority Graduate Programs (PGP), Advanced Graduate Courses for International Students, by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (MEXT). Therefore, the Graduate School of Science and Technology, Niigata University, accepts applications for October 2024 admission from those interested in pursuing a doctoral degree in this program as follows.

#### 1. Outline of the Program

Niigata University makes great efforts in promoting education and research opportunities with East Asia and the Russian Federation as the doorway from the Japanese seacoast to the world. This program, based on a request from the Ministry for Development of the Russian Far East, provides a reorganized curriculum closely in line with requests obtained in field investigations in 2013, and aims to foster advanced agricultural specialists urgently needed by the Russian Federation and to nurture Japanese researchers who possess international as well as local perspectives. Student participants in this program will be matriculated at the Graduate School of Science and Technology, Niigata University, as full-time regular students and pursue a doctoral degree by taking required courses and conducting research within three years, the standard period required to complete the program.

### 3. Eligibility for Application

An eligible applicant is considered to be someone applying as an international student, conforming to any of the conditions listed below.

- (1) Those who have a Master's degree or a professional degree (prescribed in Article 5-2 of the Degree Regulations (Ordinance of the Ministry of Education, Science and Culture No. 9 of 1953) based on the provisions of the School Education Act, Article 104-1 (the same hereafter)), or those who expect to obtain such a degree by September, 2024.
- (2) Those who have a degree equivalent to a Master's degree or a professional degree in a country other than Japan or those who expect to obtain such a degree by September, 2024. (Refer to [Note])
- (3) Those who, while in Japan, have completed a course of study by a distance learning program provided by a school in a country other than Japan and have a degree equivalent to a Master's degree or a professional degree in that country, or those who expect to obtain such a degree by September, 2024. (Refer to [Note])
- (4) Those who have a degree equivalent to a Master's degree or a professional degree upon completion of a course of graduate study, in Japan, that is conducted at an educational institution in a country other than Japan and recognized as being part of the educational system of that country, and that is specifically designated by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology, or those who expect to obtain such a degree by September, 2024.

- (5) Those who have a degree equivalent to a Master's degree upon completion of a course of study at the United Nations University (hereinafter referred to as the "United Nations University") founded based on the United Nations General Assembly Resolution of December 11, 1972, prescribed in Article 1-2 of the Act on Special Measures Incidental to Enforcement of the Agreement between the United Nations and Japan regarding the Headquarters of the United Nations University, or those who expect to obtain such a degree by September, 2024.
- (6) Those who have graduated from university and have engaged in research for a minimum of two years at a university, research institute or other such institution, and who, on the basis of the outcome (performance) of that research, are approved by the Graduate School of Science and Technology (hereafter the Graduate School) as having academic ability equivalent to or greater than those with a Master's degree. (Refer to [Note])
- (7) Those who, after completing 16 years of school education in a country other than Japan, or after completing 16 years of school education by a distance learning program in Japan provided by a school in a country other than Japan, have engaged in research at a university, research institute or other such institution for a minimum of 2 years and who, on the basis of the outcome (performance) of that research, are approved by the Graduate School as having academic ability equivalent to or greater than those with a Master's degree. (Refer to [Note])
- (8) Those who, following the individual screening of their eligibility for application, are approved by the Graduate School as having academic ability equivalent to or greater than those with a Master's degree or a professional degree and who will be 24 years old by September 30, 2024. (Refer to [Note])

Those eligible to apply on the basis of (2), (3), (6), (7), (8) as outlined above should submit the "Application Documents" and the "Application Form for Eligibility Screening of Entrance Examination" to the program director by Monday, December 25, 2023.

Eligibility screening results will be announced individually by the program director on or after Wednesday, January 10, 2024.

#### 7. Method of Admission Selection

Admission selection shall be made upon the evaluation of application documents and interview. (Note) Interviews will be conducted either face to face or by interactive vocal or visual communication via Internet.

#### 8. Interview Date

The interview will be held on one day from Monday, January 22 to Friday, February 2, 2024 (EXCEPT weekends)

Individual interview date and time will be informed from the program director.

## 9. Announcement of Admission Decision 10:00 (Japan Standard Time) on Friday, March 8, 2024

The list of successful applicants' Examinee Numbers shall be posted at the main entrance hall of the Graduate School of Science and Technology, Niigata University. Successful applicants will also be informed of the admission decision by mail.

The list shall also be posted on the Graduate School of Science and Technology website at 12:00 (Japan Standard Time) of the day of announcement. (https://www.gs.niigata-u.ac.jp/) No telephone inquiries regarding the admission decision will be answered.

## 10. Scholarship for Accepted Students

Students who are accepted to the program and meet the eligibility requirements to apply for the Japanese Government Scholarship Program may be recommended as MEXT student nominees. When they are granted the scholarship, they will receive the following support;

- (1) Monthly stipend: JPY 145,000
- (2) Period of Scholarship: For the period of the standard number of years required to complete the doctoral program (from October 1, 2024, to September 30, 2027)
- (3) Travel Expenses (Round trip):
  Students will receive in-bound travel expenses when entering Niigata University and out-bound travel expenses if they return to their home countries within the period of scholarship. The travel expenses cover air fares from the international airport closest to their residence to the
- (4) Fees Necessary for Entering Niigata University:
  Student participants are exempted from the entrance fee and tuition for the period of the standard number of years required for completion.
- (5) Other: If the student participants' stay at Niigata University exceeds the standard number of years required for completion, if they are expelled or transferred, or in any way violate the oath made to the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology, even after matriculation, the scholarship stipends will not be provided.

## 11. Eligibility Requirements to Apply for the Japanese Government (MEXT) Scholarship Program

- (1) Nationality: Applicants must have the nationality of the CIS countries at the time of application.
- (2) Age: Applicants must have been born on or after April 2, 1989.

(3) Academic Background: Those who have been granted a Master's Degree or are expected to obtain such a degree by September, 2024; those who graduated from a university and have been engaged in research for a minimum of two years at a university or research institute and who are considered, by the Graduate School of Science and Technology, Niigata University, to have academic ability, considering their research achievement, equivalent to the level required for a Master's Degree; or those who, following the individual screening of their eligibility for application, are approved as having academic ability equivalent to or greater than those with a Master's Degree and who will be 24 years old by September 30, 2024.

- (4) Major Field of Study: Those who studied one of the following fields at a university are eligible to apply: Management of Food and Resources; Plant Resource Production; Animal Resource Production; High Level Use of Plant Functions; Enhancement of Microorganism Functions; Elucidation of Food Functions; Sustainable Agricultural Produce; Conservation and Use of Forest Resources; Local Management Engineering; Agricultural Engineering; Fluctuation of Water Circulation; Atmospheric Environment
- (5) Academic Grades: Those who have had a GPA of 2.30 or higher, based on the calculation formula specified by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (MEXT), in the past years and are also expected to maintain a GPA of 2.30 or higher for the period during which they receive their scholarship stipend.
  - \*Niigata University will calculate the students' GPA upon receipt of the application documents.
- (6) Recommendation: Those who are recommended officially by the president or dean of the Graduate School of a university in the CIS countries with which Niigata University has concluded an agreement for cooperation or where there are some close collaborations with Niigata University.
- (7) Other: Any applicant who falls into any of the following categories is NOT eligible to apply for the scholarship.
  - a. Those currently in the military service.
  - b. Those who are unable to arrive in Japan by the date specified by Niigata University.
  - c. Those who apply for this scholarship from another university and who have been granted any other international student scholarship from the Japanese government (MEXT) or the Japan Student Services Organization (JASSO).
  - d. Those who expect to obtain a scholarship from an organization (including a governmental organization in their own country) other than the Japanese government (MEXT).
  - e. Those who do not meet the expected eligibility requirements or conditions by the specified date.
  - f. Those who have dual nationality at the time of application and cannot prove that they have renounced their Japanese nationality by the time they arrive in Japan.
  - g. Those who in the past were international Japanese government (MEXT) scholarship students and who do not thereafter have a study and research career of a minimum of three years by the
    - time of scholarship take-up.
  - h. Those who from the time of application hope to undertake fieldwork or an internship in a country other than Japan.
  - i. Those who failed the entrance examination for the doctoral degree program at this research department.
